Due to unavoidable circumstances Prof. M.K. Harbola, requested for leave of absence. The Chairman granted the same.

After deliberations on the agenda items, following recommendations were made :-

#### FC/2010:01.01: Opening Remarks by the Chairman

The Chairman welcomed all the members and asked the Director to begin with the progress report of the Institute.

#### FC/2010:01.02 : Overview Report of the Director

The Director welcomed members of the Finance Committee and presented a report on the progress of the Institute and the developments that took place during the period of July 21, 2009 – February 25, 2010.

Members expressed their satisfaction on the performance of the Institute on plan grant utilization.

However, members were of the view that construction activity should be further intensified. The Director informed the members that several proposals are underway and would be presented in the next meeting. Members also noted with satisfaction Institute's move on filling up of the vacant posts. Further, member expressed their concern over the delay in the audit report and advised the Institute to approach the AG office to get the audit report of 2008-09 at the earliest.

FC/2010:01.03: Confirmation of Minutes of Meeting held on 20th July 2009

Minutes of 2009/2<sup>nd</sup> Finance Committee meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> July 2009 were confirmed.

FC/2010:01.04: Recommendations of the Building & Works Committee held on 16<sup>th</sup> February 2010

The Finance Committee deliberated on the following recommendations of the Building and Works Committee and decided on each of the item as mentioned below.

(a) B&WC/2010:01:03: To consider Preliminary Estimates for the construction work of Narmada Residency-II (50 Nos of Flats)

The recommendations of B&WC for construction of 50 Nos of flats of Narmada Residency-II with a Preliminary Estimate (PE) amounting to Rs. 1598 Lacs (Rs One thousand five hundred ninety eight lacs only), including architects fee@ 5% (plus service tax as applicable on fees) and 3% contingencies were further recommended to the BOG for Administrative Approval and Financial Sanction (A/A 8 6/5)

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- (b) B&WC/2010:01:04: To consider Preliminary Estimates for the construction work of Narmada Residency-III (60 Nos of Flats)

  The recommendations of B&WC for construction of 60 Nos of flats of Narmada Residency-III with a modified Preliminary Estimate (PE) amount to Rs. 2203:58 lacs (Rs Two thousand Two Hundred and three point five eight lacs only) including architects fee @5% (plus service tax as applicable on fees) and 3% contingencies was further recommended to the BOG for Administrative Approval and Financial Sanction (A/A & F/S).
- (c) B&WC/2010:01:07: To consider the Preliminary Estimates for External HT Line.

The Finance Committee recommended the provisional PE as recommended by B&WC of Rs. 1,31,14,268/- (Rs. One Crore thirty one lacs fourteen thousand two hundred sixty eight only) for the External HT line (Phase-II) to the BOG for Administrative Approval and Financial Sanction (A/A & FS).

(d) B&WC/2010:01:08: To review the Progress of Hall of Residence I (SH.: Civil & Electrical).

The Finance Committee members deliberated on the issue of giving extension for completing the construction of Hall of Residence-I and recommended to extend the date of completion upto 31 May 2010 for Civil works to M/s NM Roof Pvt Ltd and additional one month for completing the Electrical works to M/s Bhardwaj brothers ( electrical contractor).

The members also discussed on the issue of releasing the security deposit of M/s NM Roof Pvt Ltd amounting to Rs. 43.72 lacs (deposited with the Institute) against equivalent Bank Guarantee. The committee advised the Institute to refer to the terms and conditions of the agreement signed with the construction agency. It was advised that if the terms and conditions have any provision of releasing security deposit against bank guarantee, the same might be recommended to the BOG for approval.

FC/2010:01.05: Revised Budget Estimates for the F.Y. 2009-10 and Budget Estimates for the F.Y. 2010-11.

Revised Budget Estimates for the F.Y. 2009-10 for Rs. 4605.84 lacs was recommended for approval to the Board. The Finance Committee advised the Institute to revise the Budget Estimates (B.E.) of year 2010-11 amounting to Rs. 9825.16 lacs and bring that down to approximately 6000.00 lacs. The Committee authorized the Chairman to recommend the revised estimate of 2010-11 to the BOG. (Please see FC/2010/1/Annexure-III).

FC/2010:01.06: Adoption of Revised Receipt and Payment account for the F.Y. 2008-09.

The committee recommended to the BOG for adoption of Receipt and Payments account for the FY 2008-09.

FC/2010:01/07: Placement of Audit Report for the F.Y. 2007-08 and 2008-2009

The Finance Committee recommended the Audit Report for the F.Y. 2007-08 to the BOG. As the Audit report of F.Y. 2008-09 is awaited, the Committee authorized the Chairman to approve the same to enable the institute to place it before both the houses of Parliament.

FC/2010:01/08: Implementation of Sixth Pay Commission recommendations as amended by the MHRD, GOI related to pay, allowances and other

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benefits to teaching and other Staff of Institute: Ratification of the approval accorded by Chairman, BOG.

Approval of the Chairman to implement the revised pay scales for teaching and other staff as per the recommendations of 6<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission and as amended by the MHRD, GOI vide various orders issued from time to time was recommended to the BOG for ratification.

FC/2010:01.09:

To consider and recommend the Medical Attendance and Treatment Policy of the Institute.

The committee discussed at length on the draft of Medical Attendance and Treatment Policy and recommended the same to the Board only for Faculty, Officers and other staff. The Committee also recommended to the Board the proposed policy for OPD treatment and issue of medicines to the students. However, the Finance Committee advised the institute to explore medical claim and insurance policy for hospitalization and treatment of students.

FC/2010:01.10: To consider Purchase Manual of the Institute.

The Purchase Manual of the Institute was placed before the honorable members of the Committee in the last meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> of July, 2009. A committee consisting of Shri Ashok Thakur, AS, Higher Education, Director of the Institute and Director (F), MHRD was formed to review and suggest amendments if any. Since the Director (F) MHRD requested for additional time to convey his comments, the matter was postponed for the next meeting of the Finance Committee.

FC/2010:01.11: To consider extending Mobile Phone facility to Officers & Staff on need basis

On considering the functional difficulty at remote location, the committee recommended the case for approval to the BOG with the rider that the Institute would identify the key positions of Officers and Staff (who are not eligible as per Government rules) for extending the mobile phone facility to them as per Institute's requirement.

FC/2009:01.12: Application Fee chargeable from candidates applying for various posts at the Institute

The committee recommended the charges as proposed by the institute and also included Physically Handicap candidates in exemption list alongwith SC/ST candidates.

FC/2009:01.13: Reporting Items

The Finance Committee took note of the reporting items. There were no adverse or advisory comments on the report items.

FC/2010:01.14: Any other item with the permission of Chair

(a) Fixation of monthly emoluments for Emeritus Fellow after the revision of pay scales of faculty

The Finance Committee deliberated on the issue and decided to recommend to the BOG the revised emoluments for Emeritus Fellows as per following details:

Confirmation of the Minutes of 2010/ 1st Meeting of the B&WC

held on Feb 21, 2010

Minutes were circulated after the meeting and are placed at Annexure B&WC/2010/2/A-1 (page P-7 to P-10). No comments have been received from the members.

The Building & Works Committee is requested to confirm the same.

B&WC/2010: 2.03

To consider the Preliminary Estimate for the work of Construction of Triple Seated Hall of Residence 2

A preliminary estimate has been submitted by the Architect, M/s Datta & Datta Associates, Ahmedabad for construction of Triple Seated Hall of Residence 2 having a capacity for accommodation of 498 students. The estimate amounting to Rs 2197 lacs ( Rs two thousand one hundred and ninety seven lacs only) as forwarded by the architects which is based on CPWD Delhi Plinth area rates 2007 with approved cost enhancement i.e 22% at Jabalpur, 3% contingencies and 2.5% architect fee ( as applicable for repeated works) has been placed as annexure B&WC/2010/2/A-2 (page P-11 to P-18). This estimate has been sent to CPWD for necessary vetting. The vetted estimate from CPWD shall be placed on the table in the meeting itself.

The B & WC is requested to consider the Preliminary Estimate for construction of Triple Seated Hall of Residence for an amount as vetted by the CPWD (including the architect fee separately) and to request the Finance committee to consider the same for onward recommendation to the Board of Governors for its administrative approval and expenditure sanction.

B&WC/2010: 2.04 To consider the Preliminary Estimate for the work of Construction of Visitors Hostel

A preliminary estimate submitted by the Architect, M/s Kanvinde Rai & Chowdhury, New Delhi for construction of Visitors Hostel, providing accommodation for out station visiting faculty and other guests of the Institute The estimate amounting to Rs 1078 lacs ( Rs one thousand and IIIT DM/ B&WC/ 2010/2nd Page no.2

seventy eight lacs only) as forwarded by the architect, which is based on CPWD Delhi Plinth area rates 2007 with approved cost enhancement i.e 22% at Jabalpur, 3% contingencies and 5% architect fee, has been placed as annexure **B&WC/2010/2/A-3** (page P-19 to P-37). This estimate has been sent to CPWD for necessary vetting. The vetted estimate from CPWD shall be placed on the table in the meeting itself.

The B & WC is requested to consider the Preliminary Estimate for construction of Visitor Hostel for an amount as vetted by the CPWD (including the architect fee separately) and to request the Finance Committee to consider the same for onward recommendation to the Board of Governors for its administrative approval and expenditure sanction.

#### B&WC/2010: 2.05 To consider the Revised Preliminary Estimate for the work of Construction of Lecture Hall & Tutorial Complex

The necessity of the Revised Preliminary Estimate for this work was felt when the detailed estimate against sanctioned PE had been forwarded to the CPWD. The detailed estimate was found to be reaching to an amount of 29 crore, whereas, the Administrative approval and expenditure sanction against Preliminary estimates had been for an amount of Rs 24 crore (including Architect fee). In line of the above circumstances, the Revised Preliminary Estimate has been submitted by the architect M/s Architect Atelier, Chandigarh against a modified drawing, omitting 2 numbers of Lecture Halls of 300 capacities and 2 numbers of class rooms (these Lecture halls and class rooms have been taken for future expansion). The estimate amounting to Rs 3510 lacs (Three thousand five hundred and ten lacs only) as forwarded by the architects which is based on CPWD Delhi Plinth Area rates 2007 alongwith recently approved cost index 22% for Jabalpur, 3 % contingencies & 5 % architects and also including extra provisions for special type of roofing, acoustic treatment on walls, anti termite treatment, air conditioning etc. is annexed as Annexure B&WC/2010/2/A-4 (page P-38 to P-48). The estimate has been sent to the CPWD for necessary vetting. The vetted estimate from the CPWD shall be placed on the table in the meeting itself.

The B & WC is requested to consider the Revised Preliminary Estimate (RPE) for construction of Lecture Hall & Tutorial Complex for an amount as vetted by the CPWD (including the architect fee separately) and to request the Finance Committee to consider the same for onward recommendation to the Board of Governors for its administrative approval and expenditure sanction.

B&WC/2010: 2.06 To consider Revised Estimate (RE) of the work of Shifting of 33
KV Dumna feeder away from the PDPM-IIITDM premises

The original estimate of the above work as submitted by the MPPKVV Co Ltd was of the value Rs. 9.62 lacs(Rs Nine point six two lacs only) and the same has been revised due to less provision of 33 KV line in the original estimate and also due to change of route of 33 KV line. After deliberations on the agenda items, following recommendations were made by the Committee:-

### B&WC/2010: 01:01 Opening Remarks by the Chairperson, B&WC

Chairperson and the Director of the Institute Prof. Aparajita Ojha welcomed the members and introduced special invitees with other members of the Committee. Chairperson gave a brief Power Point Presentation about the Institute's Works under construction/likely to be constructed and invited suggestions from the members present. Some of the points discussed during her presentation were the following.

- 2 4.00

- Institute Shifted to its Own Campus. Institute shifted to its own campus situated at Dumna Airport Road, Jabalpur on July 27, 2009. Basic faci ties, such as water, telephone, leased line connection etc. are now available. Other facilities will soon become available. Since the Institute campus is far off from the city and there are no means of transport, bus transport is made available to the students and employees of the institute on subsidized rates.
- Campus Construction Work. Progress of triple seated Hall of Residence I has been satisfactory. As per the Board's directive, a notice was issued to the contractor of Hall of Residence I (Hostel I) due to very slow pace of construction. The contractor was asked to complete the work by September 30, 2009 failing which the Institute would terminate the contract. After receiving the notice, the construction activities were geared up. However, the work could not be completed within the notice period. The contractor has sought extension upto May 31, 2010. Work of electric substation has been finalized and is under testing.
- Board of Governors of the Institute has taken a decision to get all major future works
  executed through CPWD. As a result, the award of tender to M/s Survi project for Lecture
  Hall and Tutorial Complex was cancelled and the work was assigned to CPWD. CPWD has
  also has been assigned the work of Mess and Dining Hall, internal road network and
  electricity services and the residential complex.

B&WC/2010: 01:02 Confirmation of Minutes of 2009/2<sup>nd</sup> meeting of the Building & Works Committee held on 18 July, 2009.

No comments were received from the members of B&WC. The Committee confirmed the minutes of the 2009/2<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 18 July, 2009.

B&WC/2010: 01:03 To consider the Preliminary Estimates for the work of Construction of Narmada Residency-II (50 Nos Staff Flats)

The B&WC discussed at length the concept drawings, design, specification and preliminary estimates (PE) of Narmada Residency-II (50 Nos of Staff Flats). The Institute's Campus is in a remote area which is about 20 Kms away from Jabalpur city. Further no public conveyance is being operated on the route to the Institute. Hence, an urgent need for staff quarters has been felt. In view of the immediate requirement, the committee recommended construction of Narmada Residency-II (50 Nos of staff flats) with a Preliminary Estimates of Rs. 1598 Lakhs (Rs. One thousand five hundred ninety eight lakhs only) including Architects Fee @ 5% + service tax as applicable on fee and 3% contingencies.

The committee requests the Finance Committee to recommend the above work to the BOG for Administrative Approval and Financial Sanction (A/A & F/S).

B&WC/2010: 01:04 To consider the Preliminary Estimates for the work of Construction of Narmada Residency-III (60 Nos Staff Flats)

The design concept, architectural drawing and the estimate amounting to Rs. 2563 lakhs for Narmada Residency- III was discussed. It was felt that the amount for construction of 60 Nos of Flats is higher compared to the local cost. However, the AE, CPWD explained that the preliminary estimates are computed on the basis of Delhi plinth area rates, adding cost index applicable for Jabalpur and cost reduction is possible only when there is a change in drawing. Other special

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invitees from CPWD also informed the members that cost is normally reduced substantially when the detailed estimates are prepared at the time of the tendering process. The Institute had also approached the Architect to suggest possible changes in the design and drawing in order to reduce the cost. In response to this, a separate estimate alongwith modified drawings was sent by the Architect. The same was put up on the table for discussion. The drawings had essentially the same concept. However, the corridors' width in each floor was reduced to 2.4 meter from the original 3.05 meters. Further, the length of Toilet, Bedroom-1, Dining and Kitchen was also reduced by 0.6 meter. This resulted in a reduction of cost upto Rs. 359.42 lakhs approximately. The B&WC discussed at length the revised concept drawings, design, specifications and preliminary estimates of the modified Narmada Residency-III (60 Nos of Staff Flats). After deliberations, the committee recommended the construction of Narmada Residency-III (60 Nos of Staff Flats) with a modified Preliminary Estimates of Rs. 2203.58 Lakhs (Rs. Two thousand two hundred and three point five eight lakhs only) including Architects Fee @ 5% + service tax as applicable on fee and 3% contingencies.

The committee requests the Finance Committee to recommend the above to the BOG for Administrative Approval and Financial Sanction.

B&WC/2010: 01:05 To consider the Preliminary Estimates for the work of Construction of Road Network of Academic Area (Phase-I)

Shri S.K. Chawla, Executive Engineer CPWD (Special Invitee) and Shri J.P. Singh, AE, CPWD (Special Invitee) informed the Committee that certain clarifications sought from the Architect have not been received so far, hence, the preliminary-cum-detailed estimates for the same have not been finalized. Therefore, the committee arrived at a decision to consider this work in the next meeting.

B&WC/2010: 01:06 To consider the Preliminary Estimates for the work of External Electrification & Lighting (Phase-I)

The B&WC has decided to consider this work also in the next B&WC meeting as the modified estimates (incorporating suggestions by CPWD to the Architect) put on table are likely to be altered in accordance with the Road Network (item B&WC/2010:01:05).

B&WC/2010: 01:07 To consider the Preliminary Estimates of External HT Line.

The estimates for the above said work has not been received from Madhya Pradesh Poorva Kshetra Vidhyut Vitran Company Ltd, but on telephonic discussion with the Superintending Engineer(O&M), MPPKVVCL on 20 February 2010 it has been assured that the estimates has been lying in the Corporate Office and the Value of estimate is likely to be the same as forwarded by SE(O&M) Office i.e. Rs. 1,31,14,268/- (Rs. One Crore thirty one lakhs fourteen thousand two hundred sixty eight only).

The B&WC recommended the PE for the External HT line to the Finance Committee for the amount of Rs. 1,31,14,268/- (One Crore thirty one lakhs fourteen thousand two hundred sixty eight only) to further recommend to the Board of Governors for A/A & F/S.

It has also been suggested that Bank Gurantee should be from a Nationalized Bank and it should have validity for a period atleast extending three months beyond the defects liability period, i.e. atleast for fifteen months.

In terms of BOG resolution No. BOG/2009: 02:04 I hereby approve the Final Accounts for the Financial Year 2009-10 of PDPM-Indian Institute of Information Technology Design & Manufacturing Jabalpur(M.P.), the same may be placed in the next meeting of FC and BOG for ratification. However, I have certain observations which may be clarified separately on file.

- (1) It is observed that an amount of Rs.2,72,49,923.00 has remained unutilized and will have to be adjusted towards the grants-in-aid payable during the next F.Y. 2010-2011. The reasons for non utilization of funds may be highlighted.
- (2) The reasons for not showing of Rs. 3,60,00,000/- fixed deposits as current assets during the F.Y. 2008-09 and showing the same as in the financial year 2009-10 may be explained.
- (3) In Schedule -11 (Current Assets, Loans, Advances etc): (a) Sl. No. A)4(a)Allahabad Bank Current account an amount of Rs. 1,65,78,318 is seen as closing balance. Keeping a large amount in current account is not prudent financial management. The amount should not have been kept idle in Current account. In this connection, Director may like to examine the period for which such amounts were kept idle and ensure that in future the expected cash flows are worked out well in advance and spare funds are so utilized as to earn the maximum interest.
- (4) In Schedule-21 (Other Administrative Expenses etc), it is observed that there is a sudden spurt in the expenditure under the following heads of expenditure – SI No. Expenditure Head

- i) Grant received during the year of Rs 41.00 crore is shown in the Statement of Receipts & Payments and the Grant Utilised during the year has been credited to Capital/Corpus Fund in the Balance Sheet and not taken as an Income in the Income & Expenditure Account being for Plan Expenditure.
- ii) As per the directions of MHRD (Tech. # SCHEDULE - 24 SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

# A] ACCOUNTING CONVENTION

The financial statements are prepared on the basis of historical cost convention, unless otherwise stated and on the accrual method of accounting as per the Common Format of Accounting prescribed by Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) for all Central Autonomous Bodies.

The account has been maintained through following vouchers: Receipts/ Payment/ Journal/ Purchase vouchers. The payment made under direct expenditure heads and through creditors under the category: General Creditors, Purchase Creditors, and Construction Creditors.

# B) INVENTORY VALUATION

Being an Educational Institution, there are no Stores, Spares (including machinery spares) as inventory items. However, the consumable and spares of computer lab have been charged to revenue at cost as and when transaction take place.

### C) INVESTMENTS

There are no investments other than Bank Fixed Deposits, which are valued at cost only. No brokerage or other expenses have been incurred in making such investments.

### DI FIXED ASSETS

Fixed assets are valued at cost of acquisition inclusive of inward freight, duties and taxes and incidental and direct expenses related to acquisition.

No fixed asset has been received directly by way of non-monetary grant during the year under consideration.

# E] DEPRECIATION

i) The Institute has not charged depreciation on the assets, being created out of Grant from Govt. of India and as per General Financial Rules 2005 it was not to be charged, as stated in the Accounting Policies in the previous year.

However, as per the report of Principal Acctt. General (Civil & Con. Audit) M.P. Gwalior vide No. OAD-II/SAR/PDPM-III/2007-08/10 dated 16<sup>th</sup> April' 2009 the accounts of the Institute were qualified being assets overstated and expenditure understated to the extent of non provision of Depreciation of Rs.1.03 crores.
