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BOG/2006/1.1 Opening Remark by the Chairman Board of Governors

The Chairman is requested to give his opening remarks in the Board of Governors meeting.

BOG/2066/1.2 Overview Report by the Director

The 1st semester of B. Tech Programme of the Institute is successfully completed and the results of the students have been published. The second semester has commenced from 2nd January 06. The Institute has made adequate arrangements for conducting laboratory experiments for the courses (a) Fundamentals of Manufacturing, (b) Mechanical Engineering and (c) Chemistry in the respective laboratories of Government Engineering College (GEC). For the laboratory classes in remaining courses the Institute has been using its own premises. Regarding laboratory classes to be held in GEC, the Institute will meet the running cost of the laboratory including small repairing of said lab building/furniture. The Institute has already purchased equipments of computer Science Lab, Physics lab, Chemistry lab, office equipments, furniture etc. Further purchases will be made as per the need of the institute.

The Institute has achieved its goal to provide laptops to its students. The availability of personal laptops will give them the opportunity to enable students to develop their technical and computational skills by practicing on software and other misc. works even when they are in their hostel. It will certainly develop the professional attitude among them in submitting assignments and projects in time.

The Institute is also processing for the subscription of online journals from ACM, IEL (including IEEE and IEE), Springer Kluwer Link, MathSciNet, Science Direct, ASME etc. through INDEST.

The Government of Madhya Pradesh and the District Administration, Jabalpur are making continuous efforts to transfer 250/300 acres of land at Mahagawan (near Dumna Airport) to the Institute. The District Administration has also accepted the proposal to build an alternative road for the village. The road constructed through the campus will therefore be not available for trespassing. With the permission of the Collector, Jabalpur, the work of construction of the wall has already been started and has been going with the satisfactory pace. The committee constituted for appointing an architect has completed its work. The recommendations of the committee are included as a separate agenda item of the present meeting.

The Institute has been making efforts for arranging residential facilities for its second batch of students. Efforts are being made to obtain one of the hostels of the Telecom Training Center for this purpose. If available, this premise shall have the accommodation for nearly 200 students wherein students of both the batches can be put up. This hostel has the facility of mess, Gymnasium, Indoor/Outdoor sports, etc.

In order to promote the all round development of its students, the Institute has been promoting their participation in extra-curricular activities. Ten students of the Institute had earlier participated in *Antragni* 2006, the Cultural Festival of IIT Kanpur. PDPM IIITDM students also organized their own games and sports festival during September 30, 2005 and October 02, 2005. 'SRIJAN 2006', the Cultural Festival of the Institute was also organized by students between January 27-29, 2006 in which students participated in various literary, musical and general knowledge related competitions.

BOG/2006/1.3 | Confirmation of the Minutes of the Board of Governors held on September 16, 2005

As already reported in BOG/2006/1.2, the construction of Boundary wall at Mahagawan has been started and initiation of works for construction of road has been taken up. Construction work of the campus building will soon be started after the architectural designs are finalized.

A minor modification in the programme of Semester II, 2005-06 has been made and is placed in the separate agenda BOG/2006/1.6.

BOG/2006/1.5 Report Regarding the Appointment and Joining of PDPM HITDM Jabalpur Faculty

On the basis of applications received after the 1st and the 2nd advertisements for the faculty positions in the Institute the two selection committees met and made their recommendations. The first Selection Committee met on July 05, 2005 and recommended the appointment of

- 1. Dr Puneet Tandon (Associate Professor) and
- 2. Dr Tanuja Shereoy (Associate Professor)

in Mechanical Engineering

Subsequently, the Second Selection Committee met on October 31, 2005 and recommended the appointment of

- 1. Dr Aparajita Ojha (Professor) and
- 2. Dr Pritee Khanna (Assistant Professor)

in Computer Science and Engineering. After the approval of these recommendations from Chairman BOG these faculty have joined the Institute. The Board is requested to ratify the above.

BOG/2006/1.6 Minor Modification in UG Programme for Semester II, 2005-06

The Academic Senate had already approved the curriculum of 4 years B. Tech Programme of the Institute (which included the second semester courses also) in its second meeting held on 10.9.05 duly approved by the BOG in its Board meeting held on 16-9-05. The Institute made all efforts to appoint faculty in Electronics Engineering. However, no one was found suitable for the selection. In view of the above, a change in 2nd semester course is proposed. More precisely, it is proposed to place "Fundamentals of Manufacturing" in place of "Introduction to Electronics" in the 2nd semester to be started from January 06. The course on Electronics is proposed to be kept in the third semester as a core course. The Senate has already approved it. The Board is requested to consider and approve the same.

BOG/2006/1.7	Starting of M Tech Programme in Design & Manufacturing in
1	Computer Science and Engineering, Mechanical Engineering
	and Electronics Engineering

The present system of technical education in our country is huge and diverse with focus on analytical capabilities. In the emerging scenario of global competition, it is needed to reorient this system of education keeping in view the current trend.

In order to achieve the goals of the Institute with special emphasis on design and prototyping of IT based engineering products, it is necessary to introduce post graduate programme. The Senate of the Institute in its meeting held on January 11, 2006 critically examined the proposal of starting the M. Tech. programme from the forthcoming semester, i.e. from I Semester, 2006-07. The Senate, in principle, has agreed to initiate the M. Tech. programme in Computer Science & Engineering (CSE), Electronics Engineering (EE) and Mechanical Engineering (ME) with specialization on Design & Manufacturing in each discipline.

The Senate has recommended the following inter-disciplinary thrust/research areas which very well fit into the academic philosophy of the Institute:

- Design, Simulation and Prototyping of Unmanned Tracked Vehicles
- Design and Prototyping of Mobile Sensor Networks
- Robotics

The Senate has further recommended that the Institute sets up core groups comprising (i) eminent faculty members from IITs and other institutes and (ii) experts from various R&D establishments to help the Institute in developing these areas. It has also suggested

that the newly admitted M. Tech. students of the Institute be required to work in these proposed areas with a focused mission.

The Senate has agreed for the strength of 10 seats in each discipline amounting to a maximum strength of 30 seats for students to be admitted in the year 2006-07. However, the Senate has suggested that the actual number of admitted students in the M. Tech. programme of the Institute be decided after examining (i) the available research infrastructure, (ii) the faculty strength and (iii) various PG level courses, designed and offered, by the faculty of the Institute. The Senate has also suggested that the new PG level courses and their course contents be placed before it in its next meeting.

The Board is requested to approve the commencement of the M. Tech. programme of the Institute with effect from Semester I, 2006-07.

Accordingly a proposal of the requirement of fund for the Revised Budget 2005-06 and Budget Estimates 2006-07 was submitted to the Ministry of Human Resource and Development vide this office letter No. PDPM-IIITDM/2005/44 dated 25/10/05. The requirement of the fund for the Revised Budget 2005-06 is for a sum of Rs. 961 lakhs and for the Budget estimates of 2006-07 is for Rs. 2363 lakhs.

The budget is prepared in two parts:- Part-I and Part-II under plan head

Part-I (Plan)

The provisions made in the Revised Budget 2005-06 and Budget Estimates 2006-07 are for the committed items like salary and non-salary components. There are thirteen heads of the Budget as specified for the IITs by the MHRD. Provision of a sum of Rs. 201.00

- III. The Architects who have submitted their master plan were invited to make the presentation before the above committee on 3rd January 2006 at Visitor's Hostel IIT Kanpur

- VI. Accordingly the 7 Architects were invited for making the presentation on 12th February, 2006 in New Delhi. All 7 Architects made their presentations before the committee. The recommendations of the committee were presented to Board: Annexure IV.

The committee recommends for the appointment of M/s. Kanvinde Rai & Chowdhry, New Delhi as the Institute Architect for the campus planning & designing of PDPM-IIITDM Jabalpur. The scale of charges & scope of work should be as per the guidelines of Council of Architecture.

3RD MEETING OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS HELD ON SEPTEMBER 16, 2005

(Minutes of the Meeting)

BOG/2005.3.1 Opening remark by the Chairman Board of Governors

At the outset, the chairman, BOG thanked the Director, HT Kanpur to accept the challenge to establish the PDPM-HTTDM Jabalpur and expressed pleasure that the Institute (PDPM-HTDM) started functioning as per scheduled programe in such a short time frame i.e. August 2005 which was announced by the Ministers of MHRD at the time of the inauguration of the Institute on February 7, 2005. This is the third HTT to enter in the academic field of the country established by the Government of India (MHRD), but with a different and new type of academic orientation. On behalf of the Government of India, the chairman assured to give full support to this newly born Institute (PDPM-HTTDM) which in future will prove the pride of the country. The chairman expressed his desire that the design and construction of the building, etc. most be state of the art that may from all corners convey the message that the Institute belongs to "Design and Manufacturing".

BOG/2005.3.2 Overview Report of the Director

The Director reported the commencement of the Academic program of the Institute from August 2005, with a present strength of 69 students admitted through AIEEE. He reported about the present course structure, faculty, laboratories/class room facilities and hostel facilities in the Institute.

In the 1st Semester five courses have been offered and three labs i.e. Physics Lab and Computer Lab and Engineering Graphics Lab have been setup. In Physical Education a compulsory course PE-101, has been introduced. Hostel facilities for girls and boys students have been made available on rental basis. A Medical Officer and a Medical Advisor of the Institute have been appointed and medical facilities to the students, faculties and staff are made available to the needy.

The Director also reported the progress made on the front of collaboration of the Institute with Japanese Government. It is informed to the Board that there was a series of meetings with the officers of Japanese embassy in New Delhi to outline the nature and extent of the collaboration. There was a meeting between the secretary MHRD and the ambassador of Japan on June 18, 2005 to identify a core group of three Senior Professors from Japan who will serve as a nodal team of collaboration including on other aspects. Presently, a detailed project proposal is being developed in cooperation with Japanese embassy.

In this reference, the Indian side consisting of the Director of this Institute and Joint Secretary (T) will visit Japan, during the period from September 24, 2005 to September 30, 2005. The Director elaborated about the scheduled meetings with different groups of Professors at various universities in Japan and with some of the leading Japanese industries. The collaboration may start from April 01, 2006.

BOG/2005.3.3 Confirmation of the Minutes/Action taken Report of the 2nd Meeting dt. June()4, 2005

The Board confirmed the minutes of the 2rd meeting of the Board held on June 4, 2005 noting the recommendation of finance committee in case of financial matters.

BOG/2005.3.4 To note the nomination of two Professors made by Academic Senate on the Board of Governors

The BOG approved the nomination of Prof. S. Bhargav and Prof. P. Gupta (Both Professors of III Kanpur) as Senate nominee on the Board as recommend by Academic Senate in its second meeting held on September 12, 2005.

BOG/2005.3.5 Overview of the Institute curriculum and courses to be offered in the semester-II as recommended by the Academic Senate.

The Director presented the overall undergraduate course curriculum and courses to be offered in the next semester as recommended by the Academic Senate. Mr. Ravi Mathur, member of the board, suggested to include courses on the Japanese Language and Humanities Programs. The Chairman also felt the need of include courses on Art Appreciation and Aesthetics, Symbolic/Visual Communication, Animation, etc. These courses will enrich the technical skills as adopted by the Institute. The Chairman also expressed his desire to extend invitation to well known artists to visit the Institute as Guest faculty from time to time.

The Chairman informed the Board that M.Tech. Program be started in Design and Manufacturing with about 10 students in each program from 2006-07. The selection of students be made on the basis of GATE/CEED.

The Board felt the urgent need of the recognition of the Institute as Deemed University by the UGC and necessary action may be taken accordingly.

After the above observations the Board took on record and approved the Institute curriculum and semester wise courses to be offered (4 years B.Tech. Program for Computer Science & Engineering, Electronics and Mechanical Engineering Branches) as approved by the Academic Senate vide its meeting held on September 10, 2005 (Enclosed in Annexure-1).

BOG/2005.3.6 Consideration of the recommendation of the 2nd meeting of the Building & works Committee held on September 16, 2005

The Board approved the recommendation of the Building and Works Committee as recommended by Finance Committee in its meeting held on September 16, 2005.

The Director informed the Board about the contractual appointment of Sri J.P. Singh, as Acting Registrar, on contractual basis for a period of 6 months and also terms and conditions as mentioned in the letter of contractual appointment with effect from August 1, 2005. The Board ratified the same.

The Director also informed that a due process of selection will be followed for appointment of the Registrar on contractual basis and action will be taken accordingly within the period of six months.

BOG/2005.3.8 Any other item with the permission of the Chair

1. Recommendation of Academic Senate to award B.Tech. Degree in Electronics from the 1st Batch session 2005-06 against the discipline of Electrical Engineering.

The Board approved to award B.Tech, degree in Electronics (instead of B. Tech degree in Electrical Engineering) from the 1st Batch (2005-06) as recommended by Academic Senate in its meeting held on September 10, 2005 (Enclosed in Annexure-2).

2. Approval of syllabus for semester 1st (HSS-101)

The Board also approved the syllabus for semester 1st (HSS-101) "Communication and Technical Writing" as recommended by the Academic Senate in its meeting held on September 10, 2005. The syllabus for HSS-101 is enclosed in Annexure-3.

3. Appointment of Professor S. Shiba as Visiting Professor, PDPM-IIITDM Jabalpur

The Director informed that Board that inclusion of Japanese Professor S. Shiba in the IIITDM concept will be beneficial for the Institute and he may be invited as the Visiting Professor to PDPM-IIITDM Jabalpur. This will enhance the prestige of the Institution. The Board approved the proposal of the Director for extending invitation to Professor S. Shiba.

4. Admission in 2006

Since PDPM IITDM Jabalpur received a very good response from the AIEEE-2005 qualified candidates for getting admission in the Institute, the Director recommended that admission in July 2006 should also be done through AIEEE with same number of seats. The Board concurred with the recommendation.

The Revised Budgets 2005-06 and the Budget Estimates 2006-07 were prepared with the hope that the land would be transferred to the Institute early in the month of November 2005. Accordingly a proposal of the requirement of fund for the Revised Budget 2005-06 and Budget Estimates 2006-07 was submitted to the Ministry of Human Recourse and Development vide this office letter No. PDPM-IIITDM/2005/44 dated 25/10/05. The requirement of the fund for the Revised Budget 2005-06 is for a sum of Rs. 961 lakhs and for the Budget estimates of 2006-07 if for Rs. 2363 lakhs.

The budget is prepared in two parts:- Part-I and Part-II under plan head

Part-I (Plan)

The provisions made in the Revised Budget 2005-06 and Budget Estimates 2006-07 are for the committed items like salary and non-salary components. These are the thirteen heads of the Budget as specified for the IITs by the MHRD. Provision of a sum of Rs. 201.00 lakhs has been made in the Revised Budget 2005-06 & Rs. 578.00 lakhs in Budget Estimates 2006-07 under Part -1 of the Budget.

Part-II (Plan)

Part II (Plan) of the Budget relates to development activities – Construction and Purchase of Equipments etc. The Figure of expenditure may change according to the change in the scheduled programme of the transfer of land. Provision of a sum of Rs. 760.00 lakhs is made in the Revised Budget 2005-06 and Rs. 1785.00 lakhs in the Budget Estimates 2006-07 seeing the futuristic plan of the Institution.

Revised Estimates 2005-06 is for Rs. 201.00 lakhs & Rs. 760.00 lakhs = Rs. 961.00 lakhs (Part-I + Part II respectively).

Budget Estimates 2006-07 is for Rs. 578 lakhs + Rs. 1785 lakhs = Rs. 2363 lakhs (Part-I + Part II respectively) only.

As the academic programme of the Institute started w.e.f. August 2005, two advertisements were made in the news papers for the selection of the faculty. The Institute could select 4 faculties only. Efforts are being made for the next advertisement for faculty position in the month of January/February 2006. The Institute could not appoint any regular non-teaching staff in the Institute due to binding of the state Covernment regarding the appointment of non-academic & academic post upto the basic pay of Rs. 11,500/- (to be appointed from the local people of the state).

However the Institute is expecting that appointment as per need of the Institution will be made in early 2006.

The Government of Madhya Pradesh and the district administrative Jabalpur are making continuous efforts to transfer 250/300 acres of land at Mahagawan (near Dumna Airport) for which all actions have been taken. The land will possibly be transferred in the month January/February 2006. The Institute has taken all initiative for construction of roads, boundary walls and also for buildings for which architects have submitted the details. Finalization of the Architects will be made in the early of the month of January 06 for which committee has been constituted. The Institute has already purchased equipments of computer Science Lab, Physics lab, office equipments, furniture etc. Further purchase will be made as per the actual need of the institute.

Total Budget for the year 2005-06 comes to Rs. 961 lakhs and for the year Estimates 2006-07, Rs. 2363 lakhs.

The actual expenditure against the provision in the budget may change and depending on the transfer of land to the institute.

The Institute is making arrangements for the boys hostel in BRBRAITT (TTC) where more than 200 students can be accommodated in a training hostel and other facilities like reading room, common room, indoor/outdoor games, Gymnasium, mess (facility) are already available. The Institute will bear the rent as mutually fixed and the running cost of the hostel. If this proposal is materialized, it will ease the problem of the Institute.

Again the next batch of students is to join the Institute in August 2006. The Institute is also planning to start Post Graduate Programme both in Design and Manufacturing in all the three branches of Computer Science Engineering, Electronics Engineering and Mechanical Engineering. The Institute will need a vast area for the same. It is viewed that for this purpose, the Institute has to construct a 2nd floor on the IT Bhawan of Jabalpur Engineering College Jabalpur for which a provision has been made for the construction of 2nd floor of IT Bhawan (Part-II, Sl. No. 12) of the Plan.

Taking into the above facts the Revised Budget 2005-06 and Budget Estimates 2006-07 of the Institute are prepared.

Presently the classes are being held in a building of Jabalpur Engineering College. There is acute shortage of residential accommodation for students.

After the detailed discussions & deliberations, the committee noted and recommends the following:

- 1. The response of architects of the advertisement dated 02.06.2005 for prequalification of architects was quite good as 25 applications were received. The Institute shortlisted 7 Architects out of 25, on the basis of their past experience in the area of Institutional campuses.
- 2. The procedure followed by the Institute after shortlisting was found to be not in order with the guidelines of Council of Architecture. Therefore the subsequent process followed after shortlisting may be scrapped and all correspondence with the shortlisted Architects be deemed as withdrawn.

- 3. Instead of publishing a fresh advertisement for pre-qualification, these 7 architects may be invited for making presentation on their profile and past experience in the area of Institutional campuses before this committee to save time.
- 4. The date & place of presentation may be February 12, 2006 at New Delhi.
