Joining of Prof HP Dikshit and Prof Madhumalti Adhikari

Prof HP Dikshit has joined the Institute as NBHM Visiting Professor with effect from June 30, 2006. Similarly, Prof Madhumalti Adkhari has also joined the Institute as Emeritus Fellow with effect from July 01, 2006.

Annual Accounts of 2004-05 and 2005-06

The Annual Accounts of 2004-05 and 2005-06 have been audited by the statutory audit of AG, MP. The audit report and the certified copy of accounts are likely to be received soon. The same will be sent to the Ministry for laying them in the Parliament immediately after they are received.

Starting of the Campus Construction (Phase I)

The Institute had made tenders in national newspapers for the construction of 2 Boys Hostels of the capacity of 408 each, the Core Laboratories Complex (CLC), the Lecture Halls & Class Room Complex (LHCRC) at a PE figure of Rs. 35 Crores. Out of 9 pre-qualified firms, 8 collected the tender documents but only 3 quoted their rates for the construction of the above projects. Due to the low competition and very high quoted rates, it was decided to re-tender the above construction. The NIT to this effect has already been advertised.

Institute Logo

A meeting of Prof Sanjeev Bhargava, Prof Amit Ray of IIT Kanpur and Mr Anindya Kastha, former M Tech student of IIT Kanpur, whose design was selected for the logo of IIITDM Jabalpur, was arranged with the Chairman BoG in New Delhi. Various suggestions for the change in the original design of the selected logo were proposed. It was decided that the matter will be re-discussed after the suggestions are received. The suggestions regarding possible changes in the logo design are still awaited.

National Center for Computational Engineering, Mathematics & Sciences

In order to decide about (i) the nomenclature of the undergraduate programme, (ii) emerging areas requiring development and enhancement of new capabilities and (iii) the possible funding agencies for the proposed activities, the Item is scheduled for discussion in the Senate of the Institute in the meeting to be held on December 28, 2006.

Distinguished Lecture Series in the Institute

Starting of the construction activity for its new campus and running of the curriculum activities of the two batches of students already admitted has taken most of the attention during the entire last semester. Initiation of the Distinguished Lecture Series will be shortly taken up.

BoG/2006-07: 3.5 | Capacity Expansion Requirements under XIth Five Year Plan

Due to the limited space currently available with the Institute in the IT Bhawan of the GEC Campus, the strength of the first two undergraduate batches of the Institute is at the level of 1/3rd of its sanctioned strength, i.e. 78 against the sanctioned students strength of 234. However, in view of reservation of 27% of its seats for the OBC, the Institute is required to increase its sanctioned strength level by 54% by raising the students strength of each batch to 360.

The planned increase in students strength over next 5 years is shown in **Annexure 2**. Since the present space available with the Institute does not permit it to increase students strength in the desired way, it has been trying hard to start the construction activities of the campus near Dumna Air Port. Though the planned increase in students strength was to double itself for admissions in August 2007 and thus take $2/3^{rd}$ students of the sanctioned strength, the same will not be feasible due to the limitation of the size of the class rooms available in IT Bhawan. However, the Institute would increase the students strength by 54% over its current intake level. Arrangements for such an intake are being made.

The increase in students strength also requires additional faculty and the staff. The required increase in the numbers of faculty and staff, worked out on Government guidelines, as shown in **Annexure 2**. Details of the non-academic staff posts, required for running the Institute at the students strength level of ~ 2000 students, including undergraduate as well as postgraduate students, are shown in **Annexure 2**. In contrast, it is proposed that the faculty strength be kept as proposed without specifying the cadre ratio within it. Such an arrangement has been followed in the case of IITs and is most conducive for attracting and retaining quality faculty members in the Institute.

Institute is keeping such requirements in mind while planning its academic and residential buildings.

The Board is requested to approve the above mentioned increase in the strength of students, faculty and the non-academic staff requirements of the Institute over next five years so that the same can be proposed to the Government for seeking the necessary approvals.

BoG/2006- 07: 3.6 | Faculty Perks/ Privileges

The Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) vide its Letter No. F-23-5/96-TS. 1, dated April 20, 2001, has sanctioned perks to faculty of IIT's. PDPM IIITDM Jabalpur has been opened on the pattern of IIT's and the scales of the faculty are equal to that of the faculties of IIT's. The order of the MHRD, in this regard is placed in **Annexure 3.** However, the implementation of the above order requires the approval of the Board of Governors of the Institute.

The Board is requested to kindly approve the above perks and privileges for the faculty of this Institute as per Government guidelines.

BoG/2006- 07: 3.7 | Honorarium to the Wardens of the Institute

Administering students in the hostels requires the appointment of wardens. IIT Kanpur is paying honorarium to the wardens @ Rs. 800 per month for each hall which has been revised now to Rs. 1500/- per month with effect from July 01, 2006, which is enclosed as **Annexure-4**. Though the number of students in the hostels of IIITDM Jabalpur is much smaller when compared to that of hostels of IIT Kanpur, the work required from them is still equally involved as the Institute does not own its own hostels and adequate number of non-academic staff to assist the wardens.

The proposal for the approval of an honorarium of Rs 1500/- per month is submitted to the Board.

Initial Appointment	

The Finance Committee of IIT Kanpur, in its 1st meeting 2001, held on 27-5-2001, has revised the moving expenses of individual on joining the Institute on initial appointment (**Annexure-5**). The recommendations are as follows:

- 1. Persons joining from abroad be reimbursed the travel expenses as per actuals for one way economic class fare for self and family (if applicable) subject to the maximum of Rs. 90,000/-
- Those who join the Institute from other IIT's OR from a Government Institution OR a Government organization OR a recognized Research and Development Laboratory OR a recognized University/ Deemed University be paid travel allowances as applicable under the Government of India TA rules, as if they are on transfer.
- For those who joined the Institute for the first time from within India OR from organizations other than those specified in Sr. No.-2 mentioned as above be paid some compensation based on individual merit on case to case basis with the approval of Board of Governors.

The Finance Committee of IIT Kanpur further recommended that bond obligation etc should be continued and the minimum period of service be fixed as 5 years or duration of contract whichever is less. This is applicable to only those who joined against

permanent position. A visiting faculty who is subsequently regularized without a break in service will also be eligible for the same.

Above recommendations of the Finance Committee have been accepted by the Board of Governors of IIT Kanpur in 2001/ 2nd meeting held on 27-05-2001.

Since this Institute is established by the Government of India, on the pattern of IIT's and the scales and other perks of this Institute are at par with IIT's, the Board is requested to kindly approve this benefit (moving expenses) to the employees of the Institute on joining on initial appointment against (i) a bond period of 5 years for those who take the moving allowance under categories of 1 and 2 above and (ii) a bond period of 2 years for those who take the moving allowance under category 3.

BOG/2006.2.6	Proposal to Host the Term of Visiting Professor to Prof. H P
	Dikshit in PDPM-IIITDM Jabalpur

The Board was informed that the National Board Higher Mathematics (NBHM) of the Department of Atomic Energy, Govt. of India has approved, two years term as a Visiting Professor to Prof. H.P. Dikshit, an honorable member of the Board and the former Vice Chancellor of IGNOU, New Delhi, at a fellowship equal to the difference between his last drawn salary and pension admissible to him. Prof Dikshit has earlier headed several important national and international institutions and organizations like AIU, IGNOU, AICTE, DEC, NCERT, SACODIL, G-munet and a few universities. Besides holding such positions he has continuously engaged in active research as evidenced by a large number of research papers published by him with several distinguished personalities in the field. The Board approved the proposal to host Prof. H.P. Dikshit, as a Visiting Professor in the Institute as a NBHM Fellow for two years. The Board also approved the additional expenses towards his conveyance and TA/DA for attending National / International Seminars / Conferences / Symposia / Meetings as per Government of India norms on being invited by the concerned Institute subject to the approval by the competent authority of the Institute.

BOG/2006.2.7 Proposal for Emeritus Fellowship to (Retired) Prof. Madhu Malati Adhikari, for one year from July 2006 to June 2007

The Board approved the proposal to appoint Prof. Madhu Malti Adhikari, former Professor of Rani Durgavati Vishwa Vidyalaya (RDVV), as an Emeritus Fellow of the Institute for one year from July 2006 to June 2007. During the above period she will be paid an Honorarium of Rs. 20,000/- per month. In addition, she will be provided conveyance and TA/DA as per Government of India norms for attending National / International Seminars / Conferences / Symposia / Meetings on being invited by the concerned Institute on approval by the competent authority of the Institute.

BOG/2006.2.8 M. Tech Programme at the Institute

"Manual for the M.Tech Programme" of the Institute, as approved by the Senate, was presented to the Board. The Director briefly presented the special features of the M.Tech programme of the Institute. The Board expressed its happiness on the procedural rigor which the Institute had been paying towards establishing its post-graduate programme.

The Board also expressed its happiness on the new admissions made for the M.Tech programme in Computer Science & Engineering and Mechanical Engineering.

BOG/2006.2.10 | Appointment offers to New Faculty

The Board ratified the approval granted by the Chairman as enclosed in Annexure – IV of the Agenda. The recommendation of the Selection Committee for the appointment of the faculty was also ratified by the Board. The Board expressed its happiness on the selection of five new faculty members of the Institute and desired that another exercise for the faculty selection be also initiated soon so that the strength of the institute faculty increases further.

BOG/2006.2.11 Approval of Research Engineer and Scientist positions (Grade-I

The Board approved the recommendation of the Finance Committee regarding appointment of Research Engineer Scientist Grade I – II i.e appointment of Research Engineer & Scientist be made in the scale of 10,000-15,200 [Grade-I] as well as Rs. 8,000-13,500/- [Grade-II] by keeping some of the sanctioned posts of the Assistant Professor in abeyance. Alternatively, the appointment of Research Engineer and Scientist in Grade-I can be done by fixing higher basic pay by giving additional increments as per the recommendation of the selection committee.

The Board viewed that a separate request for sanction of additional posts be made to the MHRD by working out the projected students strength for the next five year and detailing out the faculty and staff requirement as per Government of India norms.

BOG/2006.2.12 | Adoption of Annual Accounts 2005-06 of the Institute

The Annual Account of the Year 2005-06 (Annexure VI of Agenda), was presented. After a discussion on the same, the Board adopted the Annual Account 2005-06. The Board also suggested that the Audit of the same be done. A request to Principal Accountant General, Madhya Pradesh, Gwalior, must be made for the statutory audit of the accounts of the Institute.

BoG/2006.2.13 Appointment of the Acting Registrar in the Institute

The Board was informed that the appointment of Shri. J.P. Singh, as Acting Registrar, on contractual basis expired on July 31, 2006. The approval of the appointment on the same terms and conditions as sanctioned vide letter No. DIR/PDPM-IIITDMJ/2005-282, dated August 01, 2005, **upto March 31, 2008**, was obtained from the Chairman, which was placed before the Board.

The Board ratified the contractual appointment of Shri. J.P. Singh for a period **upto March** 31, 2008, on the same terms and conditions as mentioned in the letter dated August 01, 2005.

BOG/2006.2.14 Confirmation of Minutes of the 2006/1st meeting of B&WC held on July 14, 2006

- 1. The Institute architect presented the campus master plan depicting proposed broad zoning of (i) academic area, (ii) hostel areas and (iii) residential area for the faculty and staff. The master plan was discussed in details. However, in view of the land topography, land distribution and various functional requirements of the campus, the master plan proposed by the architect was accepted by the Board.
- 2. As desired by the Finance Committee in the meeting held on July 25, 2006, the comparative statements for the proposed estimated costs for hostels, lecture halls and class rooms complex (LHCRC) and course labs of the Institute vis-à-vis-those of IIT Kanpur were placed before the Board. It was observed that the constructed floor area per student in hostels of PDPM-IIITDM Jabalpur (27.15 sqm) was marginally higher than that of Hall-IX of IIT Kanpur which was being currently built. However, the constructed (25.85 sqm) area per student was similar to that of other hostels of IIT Kanpur. Since the land available to PDPM-IIITDM Jabalpur is undulated and thus required different approach for designing its building, the Board accepted the figures presented by the Institute.

The estimated cost of construction per sqm, of the Lecture Hall Complex including energy efficient measures and air conditioning, was observed to be lower at PDPM-IIITDM Jabapur (Rs. 14,942/-) in comparison to the same at IIT Kanpur (Rs. 16,800/-), on the other hand, the cost per sqm of hostels without energy efficiency measures at PDPM-IIITDM Jabalpur (Rs. 9,692/-) were marginally higher than those at IIT Kanpur (Rs. 9,046/-). This marginal increase was attributed to frame-structure construction approach to be followed at Jabalpur (due to inferior quality of bricks) vis-à-vis load bearing structure approach followed at IIT Kanpur (Annex - 10)

In view of the above the Board found (a) proposed the constructed area per student and (b) estimated cost of construction per sqm reasonable and comparable with that at IIT Kanpur. The Board further accepted the incorporation of energy efficiency features and associated superior specifications proposed for the two hostels.

In view of the above, the Board gave the administrative and financial approval for the construction of two 408 capacity of each Hostels, Lecture Halls and Class Rooms Complex (LHRC) and the course labs at preliminary estimates of Rs. 2384 lacs, Rs. 661 lacs and Rs. 700 lacs respectively.

3. In view of the urgency of the situation, the Chairman desired that the Institute works for building temporary and flexible structures in the campus with the aim of holding classes and labs of the Institute there from the next academic session itself. The Institute architect was requested to do the needful in this regard.

The proposal for organizing the following four Distinguished Lecture Series in the Institute on an annual basis was presented to the Board:

- 1. Vishwesharayya Distinguished Lecture in the area of Engineering Technology
- 2. Ramanujan Distinguished Lecture in the area of Computer Science & Engineering
- 3. Raman Distinguished Lecture in the area of Biological and Physical Sciences with computational applications
- 4. Tagore Distinguished Lecture in the area of Arts, Social Sciences and Humanities.

The Board was informed that these lectures (preferably two in each semester) shall be delivered by very eminent academics who shall be selected by the committee appointed by the Director. The Institute shall make them available in the printed form as part of an annual publication with CDs for their multi-media coverage. Efforts shall also be made to telecast them.

The Board appreciated the proposal and approved the initiation of the four distinguished lecture series. It also approved an honorarium of Rs 25,000/- per lecture besides TA/DA and local hospitality to the speakers.

The Director informed the Board that he had constituted an Expert Committee, with Prof Dikshit as the Convener, for advising the Institute regarding the proposal to set up a National Center focused on Computational Science and Engineering at PDPM IIITDM Jabalpur. Subsequently, a meeting of the Expert Committee was held in the office of the Secretary Education, Minister of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India on July 26, 2006 in which Prof Dikshit had made a presentation about the concept and possible directions of development of teaching and research programmes under the Center (Minutes enclosed).

The proposal to set up the National Center for Computational Engineering & Science at the Institute was discussed in details. The Board felt that the proposal was indeed commendable and would fit into the theme of the Institute, i.e. IT, Design and Manufacturing at both undergraduate as well as postgraduate levels. The Board resolved the following in this regard:

Efforts must be made to develop and introduce Research/M.Tech./B.Tech./
Dual Degree programmes in the area of computational engineering & science
from the academic session 2007-08. An expert group could be consulted for
deciding about nomenclature of such programmes.

- 2. The process of developing and enhancing new capabilities at the Institute in emerging directions must be achieved by organizing seminars and workshops in the first year.
- 3. The Institute must make a proposal for funding from an appropriate agency to set up the National Center including the Vision Statement, the need for the programme, the expertise already available at the Institute, the infrastructural support needed at the center and the budgetary provisions that must be made to create and maintain such a center over a long term.

Doctoral/Post-Doctoral level academics and professionals may be appointed as Consultants/Senior Research Associates/Fellows in the Center as per sanctioned provisions.

In continuation of this Department's communication of even number dated 26.2.1999 regarding revision of pay scales of Faculty and Scientific/Design Staff of Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs) etc. the undersigned is directed to say that in pursuance of the decisions taken in the 36th meeting of the Council of IITs held on 13.2.2001, the Government of India has decided to revise the perks of the faculty of IITs as under:

- Contingency grant for books, stationery, local travel etc. shall be Rs. 4000- per year;
- Full funding to attend one international conference once in three years with financial assistance up to Rs. 1.00 lakh per slot subject to faculty presenting a paper or chairing a session in the International Conference:
- iii. Reimbursement of telephone bills to Professors up to a ceiling of Rs.750 p.m.;
- iv. Facility of loan (on such interest rate and conditions as applicable in Government) for purchase of computer / accessories for the faculty.
- 2.0 In addition, the following perks shall continue as per the existing arrangements.
 - Reimbursement of 75% of membership fee of one international professional society:

- Full funding for attending one national conference per year by each faculty on condition that the concerned faculty is either presenting a paper or is invited to chair a session.
- 2.0 The revised perks shall be effective from 1st April, 2001.
- 3.0 It is requested that immediate action may be taken for the adoption of the revised perks for faculty of IITs. These orders may be implemented after obtaining the approval of the Board of Governors.
