<p>Senate/55/10.1 (Confidential) SWAYAM forgery cases:</p> <p>The Senate approved that students caught in SWAYAM forgery cases are mandatorily required to repeat the same course through SWAYAM in which the forgery was detected. If the said</p>	

course is not available in the list of offered Swayam courses, it may be substituted with another SWAYAM course with prior approval. The Senate also stated that the above requirement applies irrespective of the fact that the student has completed the credit requirements for the degree program or not.

Senate/55/10.2 Scholarship enhancement for PhD students after completion of 2 years:

The Senate discussed the proposal proposed by the Head Natural Science and recommended the inclusion of "Poster Presentation" in the existing clause of assistantship enhancement.

Senate/55/10.3 Medals for 2024 graduates

A list of medal awardees, as recommended by the respective committees, was presented to the Senate.

- i. The Senate recommended the list of medal awardees from the 2024 graduates (Annexure VI) to the BoG.
- ii. Further, the Senate clarified that in the case of a tie in the Academic Performance Proficiency Silver Medal, the medal will be awarded to all students who have the same CPI (rounded to one decimal point).


Senate/55/10.4 Credit requirement for Ph.D. courses to meet the UGC guidelines for teaching positions:

The Senate approved that the PhD courses over and above the minimum requirement as PhD guidelines to meet the minimum requirements for teaching positions as per the guidelines of UGC. The courses may be completed by opting for the courses already running at the Institute level or through SWAYAM during the Ph.D. program. The Senate also advised disseminating the information among all PhD scholars.

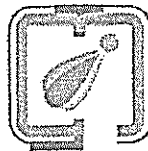





GUIDELINES & PROCEDURES OF SACS

Preamble

Discipline is an important aspect in every walk of life. Discipline in a student's life leads to better academic performance and personal development. It also helps them to live in a stress-free environment and cordially with others. The institute follows a set of guidelines and procedure for maintaining discipline among the students, and has entrusted Student Advisory Committee of the Senate (SACS) for the same.

The Student Advisory Committee of the Senate (SACS) is a standing committee of the Senate. The primary role of this committee is to ensure a fair & respectful environment for every student on the campus. It is expected that the students shall observe proper civic sense during their stay on the campus. The SACS committee performs important roles in giving advice to the students. The advice given to the student(s) helps in introspection because of their violation of civic sense regarding their action in the alleged incident. Advice is given so as to refrain other students from indulging in such or similar incidents (s)/actions (s).

This manual provides rules, guidelines, and procedures to the committee to achieve its objectives of maintaining disciplined, courteous, and culturally rich campus life that helps the students to become responsible citizens alongside their academic achievements.

1. GROUNDS FOR ADVICE

1.1 Indiscipline and dishonesty in academic matters

1.1.1 Computer Centre and other Laboratories of the Institute shall formulate rules and regulations for its users and shall display them. Such rules may also be amended from time to time. Violation of such rules and regulations shall be considered an act of indiscipline.


1.1.2 The Library of the Institute shall formulate rules and regulations for its users and shall display them. Such rules may also be amended from time to time. Violation of such rules and regulations shall be considered as an act of indiscipline.

1.1.3 In case of a complaint lodged to SACS regarding indiscipline during the conduct of an examination, SACS shall have no discretion. Such cases will be governed by the academic manual.

1.1.4 All cases of academic dishonesty, for example, plagiarism etc., shall be governed by the academic manual.

1.1.5 In case of academic suspension for 3 weeks or more academic guidelines should be followed.

1.2 Indiscipline and dishonesty in non-academic matters

The indiscipline and dishonesty in non-academic matters will be considered based on the action, involvement, support, or promotion of any of the activities mentioned below. These are for reference purposes, and any other act not mentioned below that involves damages to the reputation of the institution, violation of any rules/laws applicable to Indian citizens, damage to any property of the institution, or to any stakeholder.

1.2.1 Ragging:

Any action:

- a) Which constitutes violation of guidelines of UGC/Govt. of India as revised from time to time are mandatorily applicable
- b) Which raises fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student, and,
- c) asking a fresher or a junior student to do any act or perform something which she/he will not do in the ordinary course, and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect her/his physique or psyche,
- d) asking a fresher or a junior student to do any act or perform against his/her ~~free will~~ shall be considered by the institute as an act of ragging and therefore treated as an act of gross indiscipline by the Students advisory committee of the Senate (SACS).

Freedom

If the individuals involved in ragging are not clearly identified by the available prima facie evidence, collective punishment could be restored to act as a deterrent.

1.2.2 Objectionable behaviour with other members of the campus community:

- a) Harassment of a student or the Institute staff or anyone within the Institute premises on the basis of caste, sex, religion, etc.
- b) Disorderly conduct, whether by words spoken or written, or by an act, with the effect of teasing, treating, or handling with rudeness any other campus resident,
- c) Indulging in rowdy activities which cause or are likely to cause annoyance, hardship, or psychological harm to campus residents,
- d) Threatening with the intent to place the person in reasonable fear for his/her safety or for the safety of his/her family shall be considered as acts of gross indiscipline by SACS.
- e) In any circumstances, students should desist from the use of physical violence.

1.2.3 Unauthorized improper/conduct in the campus:


- a) Forgery, alteration, or misuse of any Institute document, record, key, electronic device, etc.
- b) theft of, conversion of, destruction of, or damage to any property of the Institute,
- c) providing false information in a deliberate, systematic, and planned manner with the purpose of misguiding Institute authorities and personnel shall be considered as acts of indiscipline by SACS.
- d) Videography (with respect to violation of privacy of any individual)
- e) Wearing indecent clothes,
- f) Indecent behaviour with any members of the campus community, etc.

1.2.4 Unauthorized conduct in halls of residence:

- a) Disrespecting the circulars of wardens and other Institute authorities regarding hall regulations,
- b) disrespecting the rights, privileges, and sensibilities of other hall residents,
- c) inducement of other students, including self-consumption of alcohol and other drugs in the Hall,
- d) organizing unlawful activities and meetings,
- e) screening of unlawful films,
- f) keeping unauthorized guests/Student in the rooms and
- g) damaging Hall property shall be considered a serious offences either by students advisory committee of the hall of residence (SACHR) or SACS for appropriate advice.

1.2.5 Indiscipline in gymkhana, its various activities/events and other organizational matters:

- a) Disrespect to student bodies such as the students senate, coordination committees, etc.,
- b) misconduct in various clubs and general events,
- c) misbehavior with participants coming from other colleges in events organized by the gymkhana or its clubs,
- d) damage to gymkhana equipment and facilities shall be considered as serious offences by SACS.

1.2.6 Participation in events that cause disturbance of peace in the campus:

Students should try to settle down issues through discussion and through meetings with the authorities. Demonstration, if any, should be peaceful and should not cause:

- a) disturbance of peace,
- b) violence,
- c) disturbance of academic activities.

Violation will be considered as act of gross indiscipline by SACS.

1.2.7 Liquor/tobacco/narcotics, etc.

Consumption, holding, or distribution of liquor, narcotics, tobacco, and other banned items by the government of India within the campus premises in any form is completely prohibited.

1.2.8 Sexual Harassment

In case of sexual harassment, six week suspension with immediate effect on first instance. If student is found to be involved for the second time then suspension upto six months.

1.2.9 Any other acts

Any other acts which are not mentioned above but are viewed as serious offences by SACS or SACHRs.

2. PROCEDURES FOR ADVISING DEFAULTING STUDENTS

2.1 Committees and their purview

2.1.1 Bodies of the institute that are authorized to advise and recommend disciplinary action(s) against defaulting student(s) shall be (i) the students advisory committee of the senate (SACS) and (ii) the students advisory committee of the hall of residence (SACHR) for each hall of residence of students.

2.1.2 While SACS shall be responsible for considering cases of indiscipline among students pertaining to (i) their overall and general activities, (ii) hostel level issues involving more than one hall of residence, and (iii) major issues of indiscipline pertaining to a given hall of residence.

2.1.3 SACHRS shall be responsible for considering cases of minor indiscipline pertaining to their own hall of residence. Thus, SACHRS shall be more or less, act as sub-committee of the SACS.

2.1.4 The chairman of the senate shall constitute a committee for SAC and SACHR.

2.1.5 Students Advisory Committee of the Senate (SACS) shall comprise of

- (a) Dean of student affairs shall be the convener.
- (b) Head counseling service,
- (c) Two wardens,
- (d) A faculty member who is not a warden of any hall of residence,
- (e) One nominee of the students' senate,
- (f) UG Coordinator of the counseling service,
- (g) PG Coordinator of the counseling service.

2.1.6 SACHR for each Hall of Residence shall comprise

- (a) Warden in charge of the concerned hall of residence (Convener)
- (b) All wardens of the concerned hall of residence.
- (c) Chief Warden
- (d) A student nominee of the counseling service who shall be a resident of the concerned hall of residence.

2.2 Filing and Admitting a Complaint

2.2.1 When an act of indiscipline is committed by a student or a group of students, any member of the faculty, staff, or student body may file a written complaint with the convener of SACS or the convener of SACHR of the concerned hall of residence, as the case may be, within a reasonable time, stating the nature and circumstances of the alleged act of indiscipline.

2.2.2 Convenor, SACS or the convener, SACHR may also take suo motu cognizance of an act of indiscipline.


2.2.3 After a complaint has been received, the convener, SACS or the convener, SACHR, as the case may be, shall make the preliminary examination of the case by collecting as many prima facie details of the case as possible and shall convene the meeting of the concerned advisory body within 7 days of the filing of the complaint.

2.2.4 Any institute faculty/administrative staff members may also forward or report an incident to the SACS/SACHR.

2.3 Procedures adopted by SACS/SACHR after admitting a complaint

2.3.1 All efforts shall be made to hear the witnesses of the case/complaint directly before the committee for the purpose of verifying the details of the incident.

2.3.2 If so required, the committee may also solicit help from professional experts for determining the veracity of facts brought to its notice.

2.3.3 Student(s) against whom the complaint has been lodged shall be given a fair chance to defend their case before the committee by giving them an advance notice, and if the need be, to present evidence and witnesses in their defense.

2.3.4 During the course of hearing, i.e., till it is completed, members of the committee may ask questions at any point, seek additional materials or testimony, visit any relevant location, recall or review evidence or testimony provided earlier, and in general seek to obtain information relevant to the case from any source.

2.3.5 During the course of investigation and hearing of the complaint, the committee and its members shall be required to maintain utmost confidentiality about the deliberations made in its meetings.

3. ADVICE: ITS NATURE AND MODES

3.1 Method of arriving at the recommendation

3.1.1 Considering seriousness of the violation committed by the student(s), the SACS or the SACHR, after completing the enquiry of the case, shall recommend the appropriate advice for the student (s) concerned for its implementation.

3.1.2 At least 2/3rd of the members of the committee shall be required to be present at the meeting of the committee in which the final view of the incident is to be taken. At least one student member (or his/her nominee) should be present.


3.1.3 All efforts shall be made by the convener of the committee to reach a consensus regarding the nature of advice to be given to the concerned student(s). However, if the same is not possible, the decision shall be taken by the simple majority of those who are present in the meeting, and only in case of a tie, the convener shall cast his vote.

3.1.4 At the completion of the hearing, the convener shall make summary remarks and shall circulate minutes to every member of the committee except student members. The student members will only be shown the final minutes in the presence of the convener.

3.1.5 If there is a split in the opinion regarding the nature of advice to be given to the concerned student(s), every member shall be entitled to give a note of dissent in writing. A note of dissent, if given, shall be required to be annexed to the recommendations made by the committee.

3.2 Possible Modes of Advice by SACS

3.2.1 The SACS shall give specific thoughts to consider the following aspects pertaining to the advice to be given to the concerned student(s):

(a) The advice given to the student(s) helps in an introspection by her/him/them regarding her/his/their action in the alleged incident,

(b) The effect of the action taken by the Institute on other students and it should force them to refrain themselves from indulging in such or similar incidents/actions?

3.2.2 Recommendation

As a recommendation regarding a given case, the SACS may advise the following or any other, or a combination thereof:

3.2.2.1 Warning

Warning, the mildest form of the advice, shall be a formal admonition issued in writing to the concerned student(s) with the expectation that the concerned student(s) shall be able to refrain themselves from any future violation.

3.2.2.2 Incorrect Information

Suppression of facts or misleading information during investigation will lead to a doubling of the punishment.

3.2.2.3 Community Service

The institute authority will decide on community service for students involved in incidents of a minor and common nature, where a student may not fully understand the impact of their actions on other students or the system. In such cases, the student may be advised to undergo community service for a specified duration.


This recommendation should be designed in a way that encourages the student to reflect on their behaviour, with the objective of refraining from such objectionable actions in the future

3.2.2.4 Restitution

For furniture etc. of Institute or the Hall of Residence, a student should be asked to pay up to four times the charge towards restitution. In such a case, the committee shall also fix a time limit (not more than 15 days) within which the amount is to be paid by the defaulting student(s). If specific person(s) is/are not identified, then a fine will be imposed collectively on all residents of the respective block/entire hostel. In case of furniture, it shall be the best quality available in the market (Godrej, etc.) with no depreciation taken into account. If a student fails to pay within the specified time, they will not be allowed accommodation in the hostel after that period.

3.2.2.5 Drug/ Alcohol/ Tobacco within institute premises.

a. For consumption, possession, and delivery of alcoholic drinks: up to six weeks suspension with immediate effect (first time). If the student is found involved for the second time, in similar case, then minimum six month suspension.

b. For consumption, possession, and delivery of any of the prohibited drugs as per the Anti-Drug policy of the Government of India: six months suspension with immediate effect and termination from the institute, if found a second time.

c. For consumption, possession, and delivery of a tobacco item: Rupees five thousand for the first time use and 21-day suspension, if found a second time.

3.2.2.6 Physical Violence

Any student or group of students indulging in physical violence with any member of the campus community shall be immediately placed under suspension for the existing/current semester. If the incident is repeated, then the academic program will be terminated.

3.2.2.7 Self-harm

Any student with suicidal tendency shall be referred to institute psychological counselor and decision of the said counselor will be final and binding on the student. For such students, the institute will not be responsible, and he/she will not be allowed to reside within the campus. Parents/guardians will have to make appropriate arrangements for their ward for the normal academic program.

3.2.2.8. Social Media:

a. No.spreading of information related to the institute/ hostel in any form on social media without permission from the competent authority. In case of any violation, 15-day suspension with a fine of Rs. 5,000/- with immediate effect and up to six months suspension, if found a second time.

b. Students should use polite language in their emails while communicating with the institute authorities and with all members of the institute community. They should not send anonymous email/malicious/instigating email, or attempt to defame any individual or group through email. In case of any violation, a 15-day suspension with a fine of Rs. 5,000/- with immediate effect and up to six months suspension, if found a second time.

3.2.2.9 Fine

The SACS/SACHR may advise the imposition of a non-refundable fine of an appropriate amount. In such a case, the Committee shall also fix a time limit (not more than 15 days) within which the amount is to be paid by the defaulting student(s).

3.2 2.10 Disciplinary Probation (DP)

Disciplinary Probation (DP) shall be a status imposed on student(s) for a specified period of time during which they shall be required to demonstrate conduct conforming to the institute norms and value system.

Conditions restricting privileges or eligibility for participating in otherwise normal student activities, such as contesting an election for a post of student's gymkhana or hall of residence, holding the coordinatorship of a club, membership of a committee of the Institute, etc, may also be imposed during the period of the disciplinary probation (DP). In case the concerned student is holding an elected or nominated post and is placed on disciplinary probation, she/he will be considered as deemed resignation from the post immediately.

Misconduct during the probationary period or violation of any conditions of the probation may result in further disciplinary action. During the period of investigation, a student shall be under DP by default.

3.2.2.11 Debarring from the students placement cell of the Institute

The SACS may advise the non-registration of a defaulting student from the students' placement cell of the Institute. He/she shall not be given an internship/placement in the institute.

3.2.2.12 Suspension from the programme

The SACS may advise the suspension of the student for the specified period of time. The specified period of time shall be the remaining duration of the semester in which the advice is given and may include subsequent semester(s).

The student(s) put on suspension shall be required to vacate the hall and the institute premises within 12 hours. She/he shall also be debarred from using the Institute facilities such as the

Library, Computer Center, laboratories, etc. during the period of her/his suspension.

For the semester in which the student's status has been suspended the fee paid by him/her will not be refunded/adjusted.

3.2.2.13 Withholding of degree


The SACS may advise withholding of the degree of a defaulting student for a specified period of time. No provisional certificate, stating that all academic requirements of the programme have been completed by the student, shall be issued to the concerned student(s) during such a period.

3.2.2.14 Expulsion

The SACS may advise the permanent termination of student status from the Institute.

3.3 Possible Modes of Advice by SACHRs

Modes of advice by SACHRs shall be

4 IMPLEMENTATIONS OF ADVICE

4.1 Advice given by SACHRs

4.1.1 Convener of SACHR shall submit its committee's recommendation for approval, along with the note of dissent, if any, to the Convener SACS, who will send them to the chairman of the senate for approval.

4.1.2 If the chairman of the senate or the convener SACS is of the opinion that all the facts relating to a complaint have not been fully taken into account, they shall have the right to send the recommendations back for reconsideration to the convener SACHR of the concerned hall of residence. In such a case, the convener SACHR will reconvene the meeting.

The SACHR shall review the case in light of fresh evidence provided and may make fresh recommendations.


4.1.3 Till the recommendations of the SACHR are approved, all members of the committee shall maintain utmost confidentiality regarding the recommendations made.

4.1.4 After recommendations on a given case are approved, convener SACHR shall call the concerned student(s) within ten days after the approval has been received and advise them on their future course of action. In case, the student is not available in the campus, a letter/order informing about the recommendations/future course of action shall also be issued to the student and his parents.

4.2 Advice Given by SACS

4.2.1 Convener of SACS shall submit its committee's recommendation for approval, along with the note of dissent, if any, to the chairman of the senate for approval.

4.2.2 If the chairman of the senate is of the opinion that all the facts relating to a complaint have not been fully taken into account, she/he shall have the right to send the recommendations back for reconsideration to the convener SACS. In such a case, the convener SACS shall reconvene the meeting. The SACS shall review the case in light of fresh evidence provided and may make fresh recommendations for approval.

4.2.3 Till the recommendations of the SACS are approved by the chairman of the senate, all members of the committee shall maintain utmost confidentiality regarding the recommendations made.

4.2.4 After recommendations on a given case are approved, convener SACS shall call the concerned student(s) within ten days after the approval has been received and advise them on their future course of action.

5 APPEALING AGAINST THE ADVICE

5.1 Student(s) shall have the right to appeal against the advice.

5.2 All appeals for reconsideration of the case shall be addressed to the chairman of the senate. The appeal may be for reconsidering the entire advice or for reducing the punishment envisaged in the advice.

5.3 The chairman of the senate, after examining the appeal, shall have the right to dispose of it or mark the same to the convener SACS or the convener SACHR for reconsidering the advice along with his/her comments/observations. The entire case may be reopened if a new set of evidence pertaining to the case is presented with the appeal.

5.4 The mere fact that an appeal has been filed against the advice shall not be the reason to withhold the implementation of the advice.


6 GENERAL ISSUES

6.1 The senate or the chairman of the senate may constitute a separate committee to look into a specific incident causing concern in the Institute. In such a case, the matter shall not be referred to SACS; recommendations shall be made directly to the chairman of the senate.

6.2 Provisions of this manual may be amended, changed, added at any time by the senate

6.3 Student given a semester drop as punishment will not be allowed the privilege of completing their courses of that semester (or any other course dropped in lieu of that semester courses) during the summer semester. However, any other backlog course or improvement course from other semesters may be allowed by the Dean (Academic), as per the academic rules of summer semester.

6.4 Student given a drop of x days as punishment will be considered as his absence from classes/academic program and guidelines of academic manual will be fully applicable.
