Senate/ 2010-11/1 Termination of UG and PG Students

The Convener, UGCS and PGCS presented the APEC report of terminated students before the SENATE. 21 UG students and 2 doctoral students were placed on termination based on their academic performance. The SENATE deliberated on the performance of the students and their previous record one by one. The Senate recommended giving one more chance to doctoral candidates. Also, it decided to give one more chance to the UG students if their SPI≥4 or CPI≥4 in the last semester and they were not placed on termination in a previous semester. The above students will not be allowed for appeal if they will be placed on termination again. Based on the decision, following students were allowed for registration and they will be placed on academic probation.

Two students were recommended to give one more chance because their second semester was dropped and the performance can't be judged from last one semester (Third semester).
