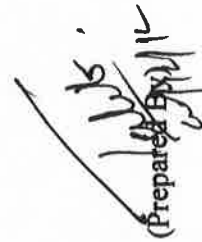

Minutes of the PGCS meeting

A meeting of PGCS was held on January 2, 2013 in the Conference Room of the Institute. The following members were present in the meeting.

Following points are decided in the meeting

1. **Appeal of PG students under termination:** Eight PG students appealed against termination of their program and requested to give them a chance. After deliberations among the PGCS members and considering the feedback of their supervisor, PGCS had made the following recommendations:

(i) **Sadanand Yadav (1110205):** Mr. Sadananad Yadav was having a CPI of 6.7 at the end of II semester of his MTech program, but could not perform well in the Seminar I. His supervisor has commented on his capability to carry out research in the field of "Signal Processing". The committee decided that looking to his past performance, he may be given a chance provided he is willing to changes his area of research. If his appeal is accepted, due to change of research area, his course work would be reviewed and in case a need be, he may have to do a course in the new area of research. In case the need be, he can opt for change of guide.

(ii) **Alok Kumar (1220303):** Mr. Alok Kumar was having a CPI of 5.2 at the end of Semester I and 6.0 (SPI of 7.5) at the end of Semester II of his master program. He has obtained two X grades in the thesis work. His guide comment was that in this semester he had focused only on the course work. PGCS recommends to accept appeal of Mr. Alok Kumar as his academic performance has significantly improved (He got a SPI of 7.5 in II semester as compared to 5.2 at the end of I semester). In







case his appeal is accepted, he would have to take an extra course in the current semester so that his CPI becomes more than or equal to 6.5. At the same time he would be allowed to register for thesis credits of 8 in the current semester and will perform satisfactory in the thesis work.

- (iii) **Shailendra Kumar Kunkal (1210211):** Mr Shailendra Kumar Kunkal has obtained a CPI of 5.5 at the end of Semester I of M.Tech. He has given medical and family reasons for poor performance. After discussing with the instructors and faculty members, who were counseling him during the last semester due to his mental stress and depression, and looking to his circumstances during the last semester, PGCS recommends giving him another chance.
- (iv) **Kirtiman Singh (1220502):** Mr. Kirtiman Singh was having a CPI of 5.8 at the end of I semester and 6.3 at the end of II semester. His performance is satisfactory in all subjects except "Mini Project" where he has secured an 'F' grade, which if replaced would improve his CPI. Looking to the significant improvement in the performance (from SPI of 5.8 to 6.8). PGCS recommends accepting his appeal.
- (v) **Devendra Jaiswal (1110402):** Mr Devendra Jaiswal secured a CPI of 7.3 (SPI of 7.3) at the end of Semester I, CPI of 6.6 (SPI of 5.9) at the end of Semester II and CPI of 6.1 (SPI of 5.1) at the end of Semester III at the end of their MDes programme. He has also gone for internship without giving any information to academic office and discipline (Head) during the summer term of 2011-12. Further, there was also a complaint from the faculty of Design Discipline about his insincere behavior also. Looking to the decreasing academic performance (from SPI of 7.3 to 5.1) and insincerity, PGCS recommends that his appeal may not be considered.
- (vi) **Lokesh Kumar Verma (1110403):** Mr Lokesh Kumar Verma secured CPI of 7.0 (SPI of 7.0) at the end of Semester I, CPI of 6.7 (SPI of 6.4) at the end of Semester II and CPI of 6.2 (SPI of 5.3) at the end of Semester III of his MDes programme. He has changed the guide in between the semester, after almost one and a half year of his academic programme. He has gone for internship without giving any information to academic office and discipline (Head) during the summer term of 2011-12. Further, there was also a complaint from the faculty of Design Discipline about his insincere behavior. Looking to the decreasing academic performance (from SPI of 7.0 to 5.3) and insincerity, PGCS recommends that his appeal may not be considered.
- (vii) **Ajeet Kumar Giri (1210361):** Mr. Ajeet Kumar Giri was having a CPI of 6.0 at the end of Semester I of PhD program. He secured 'B' grade (8.0)

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in one course and 'D' grade (4.0) in another. He received two satisfactory grades in the thesis work. According to his supervisor, he would be able to cope up with the deficiencies. PGCS recommends accepting his appeal and giving one chance as his CPI is computed based on only two subjects and he has to do a minimum of two more courses (if need be, if may go for more courses). In case, he wishes to pursue research in the domain of CFD, he would have to repeat the course of CFD.

(viii) **Ashwini Kumar Upadhyay (1210161):** Mr. Ashwini Kumar Upadhyay has obtained a CPI of 6.4 in Semester I of his PhD program. According to him, due to his father's ill health he could not concentrate on his studies. Looking into the circumstances and a CPI of 6.4 (a deficiency of 0.6 points against the required CPI of 7.0), PGCS recommends that he may be given a chance.

It is also proposed that all students whose appeal is accepted will be kept on reduced load.

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2. **Application for conversion of category from Sponsored to externally registered:** PGCS has recommended that category conversion for Sponsored category candidates be treated at par with regular category candidates, similar to the rule of Relaxed Regular Category. The supervisor will form a committee recommended by convener PGCS and approved by Chairperson Senate to evaluate the candidacy for category conversion. The student is required to submit all the relevant documents as per the guidelines of Senate of relaxed regular category.
 3. **Case of Mr. Santosh Singh Rathore being offered admission in Ph.D:** Mr. Santosh Singh Rathore has been offered admission to Ph.D. programme in the current semester (Semester II, 2012-13) while pursuing his MTech from the Institute. Mr. Santosh Singh Rathore has submitted his thesis on December 31, 2012 but not defended the same so far. PGCS discussed the case and recommends that only in case he defends the M.Tech. dissertation before the last date of late registration, he may be allowed to register in the current semester.
 4. **Professional Communication Skills Course for PhD students:** There are some students who have completed their M.Tech. programme from the Institute and are admitted to the Ph.D. programme. These students have already passed the course of Professional Communication Skill. Hence, PGCS recommends giving waiver to such students for the course "Professional Communication Skill" i.e. the students who have cleared the course during their Masters program.

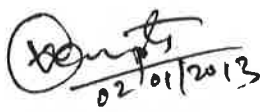
5. Change of Supervisor if a faculty proceeds on leave: A few faculty members proceed on long leave from the Institute for different reasons. In such cases applications are received from the corresponding supervisor regarding adding a co-supervisor. PGCS discussed the cases in detail and recommends following guidelines for the allotment of supervisor

- (i) If the period of leave is less than six months, a programme coordinator will be appointed who would be acting as supervisor for all academic, practical and official communication.
- (ii) If the period of leave is more than six months and less than 1 year, a co-supervisor would be appointed to carry out the research work.
- (iii) If the period of leave is more than one year or supervisor joins other organization in country, a new supervisor would be appointed. The faculty who is on leave may be the co-supervisor if the need be.

In all the above cases, recommendation of Progress Evaluation Committee / Research progress committee is mandatory.

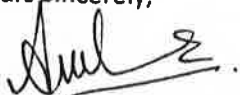

In view of the comments from the senate members (Proposal circulated among the senate members on January 23, 2011), the modified proposal for the relaxation for the PhD programme is given.

PhD Scholars in regular category who got a job offer can get relief from the programme as a special case, while keeping their registration alive on payment of a required fees every semester with the consent of thesis supervisor(s), recommended by PGCS and approved by Chairperson Senate if they have completed their

- (a) Minimum residential requirements
- (b) Course Works
- (c) Comprehensive Examination
- (d) First Progress seminar with proper direction of research

The student has to give one progress seminar before the Evaluation Board as per the following guidelines in each semester.

The Evaluation Board of a Doctoral student shall consists of

- (i) At least three but not more than five faculty members from the discipline of the student including his/her supervisor (s) and
- (ii) One faculty member from a different discipline.

The Evaluation Board shall be framed by the thesis supervisor(s) and approved by the Convener of the PGCS. The thesis supervisor of the student shall be the Convener of the Board. The maximum duration under this category shall normally be of 6 years.

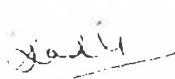

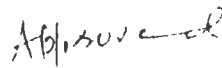

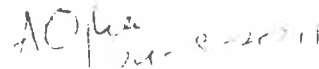

Senate/2010-11/2.10 Relief from PhD Programme

The comments of the Senate members were considered on the proposal circulated to them on 28th January, 2011 and the modified proposal for relaxation from Ph.D. programme was placed before the Senate. The proposal was finally approved by the Senate with the following additional conditions/modifications.

- (i) The title of the category would be "External - Self Supported" in place of "Relaxed Regular Category".
- (ii) In case a student wants to leave the Ph. D. programme to take up a job offer, he/she should have applied for the job through proper channel (PhD guide(s) and on the approval of the Convener, PGCS).
- (iii) The student would be required to submit a no objection certificate from his future employer that he/she would be allowed to continue with the PhD programme.

It was suggested by Dr. Khandekar that the relief from PhD programme should generally be discouraged. It should be considered only in exceptional circumstances and on the recommendation of the guide(s). The suggestion was supported by others present in the meeting, keeping in view that a PhD student is well groomed for research by his guide and considerable time and energy is devoted by the guide to bring him to the level from where he can start making meaningful contribution towards research. At this level, if the student leaves the Institute, it would be a loss to the Institute at large and to the guide in particular. The suggestion was unanimously approved by the Senate.
