

Authors Guidelines

Prospective authors are invited to submit original technical papers for publication in the DeW 7.0 Proceedings and for presentation(s) in the workshop. Papers should be formatted according to the Author Guidelines described here. All papers must be written in English and submitted in PDF format.

Submitted papers will be reviewed by experts selected by the technical program committee for their demonstrated knowledge of particular topics, originality of the work/results, innovation level and potential for practical application. High quality review articles will also be considered. The progress and results of the review process will be notified to the corresponding author by email and may also be posted on this website.

It is very important to follow a series of rules in the typographic and geometric format. This helps to communicate correct meaning of the authors to the reviewers and readers. The uniformity in the typographic and geometric format ensures that if these articles are printed, no special tricks or specific paper sizes are needed.

Instructions and Policies

- **Blind review:** DeW 7.0 reviewing is single blind, which means that authors do not know the names of the reviewers of their papers.
- **Dual submissions:** By submitting a manuscript to DeW7.0, the authors guarantee that it has not been previously published (or accepted for publication) in substantially similar form. Furthermore, no paper which contains significant overlap with the contributions of this paper either has been or will be submitted during the DeW 7.0 review period to either a journal or a conference.
- **Author's responsibilities:** The article must not contain any libelous or unlawful statements or in any way infringe the rights of others. All authors must read and agree to the content of the submitted article. Corresponding author shall be responsible for any noncompliance.
- Accepted papers **MUST** be presented at the workshop by one of the authors, or, if none of the authors are able to attend, by a qualified surrogate. The presenter **MUST** register for the conference before the deadline given for author registration. Failure to register before the deadline will result in automatic withdrawal of your paper from the DeW7.0 proceedings and program.
- For one registration: Each registrant may upload up to two papers. Additional charges shall apply for more than two papers.

Preparation of the Paper

- The paper **MUST** be formatted according in the [Double column format](#). Authors may use [Microsoft Word](#) templates.
- Papers should be no longer than 8 pages, including all text, figures, and references. A maximum of two extra pages can be allowed with additional extra page charges, which is Rs. 500 or US\$50 per page respectively for Indian and Foreign authors.
- All submissions must be in A4-sized PDF.

- All fonts and subsets must be embedded. Times New Roman font is strongly encouraged.

Electronic Paper Submission

When you have your document file ready (in pdf format), gather the following information before entering the submission system:

- Affiliation, email address, and mailing address for each author
- Paper title
- Text file containing paper abstract text, in ASCII text format (for copying and pasting into web page form)

To submit your document and author information, go to the 'Paper Submission' link on the DeW 7.0 homepage and follow the instructions. The submission system ([easychair](#)) will present an entry form to allow you to enter the paper title, abstract text, review category, and author contact information.

ALL authors must be entered in the online form, and must appear in the online form in the same order in which the authors appear on the final version of the PDF.
