If class X certificate does not have date of birth, any supporting document such as birth certificate is to be uploaded. All the documents must be in single PDF file.
- Certificate for passing of the qualifying examination, i.e. Senior Secondary [10+2] or equivalent from any system of education as recognized by the Association of Indian Universities (www.aiuweb.org).
- Certificate showing the details of successful completion of Mathematics, Physics and one of the subjects from (Chemistry, Bio-technology, Computer Science, Biology) in 11th AND/ OR 12th, as applicable in the respective boards. Applicants appearing for the qualifying examination with the above mentioned subjects in the academic year 2019-20 and expecting their final results latest by November 30, 2020 may give an undertaking.
- SAT score card
- Copy of Passport.
- Country residential proof.
- Proof for Source of Income.
- Police verification report of your country with medically fit certificate.
- Copy of valid VISA (required at the time of physical reporting)
- Good quality passport photograph (front facing).
- Certificate for vacinations
- Receipt for payment of balance fees.

Additionally, at the time of Physical reporting you should bring the following duly filled-in forms, downloadable from the Institute website (at the time of Physical reporting).

- Medical Certificate of fitness from the doctor, not below the rank of Senior Medical Officer in prescribed format.
- Anti-Ragging Affidavit on Stamp Paper of Rs. 50/- by the student & Anti-Ragging Affidavit on Stamp Paper of Rs. 50/- by the Parents/Guardians. prescribed format (at the time of Physical reporting)
