- 3.01 Discuss the need of making necessary arrangements for students of UG 2017 staying in Hall 1 to be able to stay with the rest of their batchmates.
- 3.01.01 Coordinator, Counselling Services highlighted the above mentioned need. Dividing the batch at such an early stage could create a permanent effect on their sense of inclusion in the batch.
- 3.01.02 It was proposed by the Student Senate that the students of UG 2017 who reside in Hall 1 can be shifted to Hall 3, to temporarily live with their other batchmates as four people in each room.
- 3.01.03 It was further added that although there will be a space crunch, the need of UG 2017 students staying together surpasses the need of sufficient space provided. Moreover, the students are already staying in double occupancy in Hall 1, in rooms meant for single occupancy.
- 3.02 Suggest measures to accommodate students of UG 2014 who are currently on external PBI
- 3.02.01 The Student Senate believes that the Department of Planning and Development should provide the status of the PG Hostel and a tentative period of completion.
- 3.02.02 The following three solutions were proposed by the members present in the meeting:
- The committee for hostel reallotments proposed that MTech, MDes and PhD 2017 students residing in Hall 1 should be shifted to Hall 4 and BTech 2014 students should be shifted to Hall 1 instead. When external PBI students arrive in November, they will be accommodated in double occupancy in the rooms occupied by their batchmates in Hall 1.
- Some PG representatives of the Senate proposed that the rooms vacated by students of UG 2017 could be occupied by 66 students of BTech 2014.
- It was also proposed that when the BTech 2014 external PBI students return in November, the MTech and MDes students residing in Hall 1 can shift into double occupancy leaving rooms vacant for the external PBI students to shift into, in double occupancy as well.
- 3.03 Explore the possibility of providing single rooms in Hall 1 to students of UG 2014
- 3.03.01 The Student Senate highlighted that the UG students of any institute have a sense of belonging and attachment with the institute. UG 2014 being in their final

year should therefore be provided with rooms together for the entire batch. Hall 1 has been the Hall of Residence for final year UG students which is why the students of UG 2014 have also put forward a request for the same.

3.04 Any other matter related to hostel reallotments

3.04.01 The provision of PG Hostel should be of utmost importance so as to accommodate the increased number of students in the institute.

3.04.02 The Student Senate concluded that the suggestions offered should be discussed with Dean, Student Affairs so as to eventually resolve the issue.
